Kosovo Prosecutorial Council, based on Article 110 paragraph 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of Kosovo, Article 7 paragraph 1 subparagraph 1.6, Articles 20 and 21 of Law no. No. 06 / L-056 on the Kosovo Prosecutorial Council, Article 7 of Law no. 05 / L-034 on Amending and Supplementing Law no. 03 / L-225 on the State Prosecutor and Article 8 of Regulation no. 07/2015 on Recruitment, Examination, Appointment and Re-appointment of State Prosecutors and Decision KPC / No. ___ / 2021 of 27 April 2021, re-announces:

PUBLIC COMPETITION

For the recruitment of sixteen (16) State Prosecutors at the level of basic prosecution offices of the Republic of Kosovo:

1. Four (4) positions for prosecutors in the General Department of the Basic Prosecution in Prishtina;
2. Four (4) positions for prosecutors in the General Department of the Basic Prosecution in Gjakova;
3. Three (3) positions for prosecutors in the General Department of the Basic Prosecution in Ferizaj;
4. Two (2) positions for prosecutors in the General Department of the Basic Prosecution in Peja;
5. Two (2) positions for prosecutors in the General Department of the Basic Prosecution in Gjilan;
6. One (1) position for prosecutor in the General Department of the Basic Prosecution in Mitrovica;

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF STATE PROSECUTORS

The duties and powers of State prosecutors include:

1. exercise prosecutorial functions independently, fairly, objectively and impartially, and ensure that all persons are treated equally before the law;
2. implementation of the highest standards of care in the performance of official functions;
3. honest and professional conduct in both personal and professional life in accordance with applicable laws and the code of professional ethics;
4. to preserve the honor and dignity of the State Prosecutor;
5. protect the rights of victims, witnesses, suspects, accused and convicted persons;
6. take necessary legal action to detect criminal offenses and detect perpetrators of crime, as well as timely investigation and prosecution of criminal offenses;
7. take decisions on initiating, continuing or terminating criminal proceedings against persons suspected or accused of having committed a criminal offense;
8. file indictments and present them to the court;
9. to exercise regular and extraordinary legal remedies against court decisions;
10. cooperate with the police, courts and other institutions;
11. take all other actions as specified by law.

LEGAL CRITERIA REQUIRED

Article 7 of Law no. 05 / L-034 on Amending and Supplementing Law no. 03 / L-225 on the State Prosecutor provides:

7.1. Candidates for appointment as State Prosecutors must meet the following conditions:

1. be a citizen of the Republic of Kosovo;
2. have a valid law degree in Kosovo;
3. have passed the bar exam, accepted according to the Law applicable in Kosovo;
4. have a high professional reputation and personal integrity;
5. not be convicted of a criminal offense;
6. have at least three (3) years of experience in the legal field, and
7. have passed the examination for prosecutors, in accordance with the conditions and procedures set out in a special regulation approved by the Council.

7.2. For the purposes of this article, experience in the legal field includes experience in legal matters in local and international institutions and organizations, experience as a notary and private bailiff.

ONLINE APPLICATION

Candidates will have the opportunity to apply only through the online system which will be available from **May 11, 2021 to May 25, 2021** in special links which will be placed on the official website of the Kosovo Prosecutorial Council and the Prosecutor of State or directly from the link as follows:

All candidates who have been notified that they meet the legal criteria for the competition for prosecutors announced on May 22, 2020 according to Decision KPC / No. 237/2020, are considered to have applied in this re-announcement and do not need to apply again.

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS UNDER ARTICLE 8 OF REGULATION NO. 07/2015 ON RECRUITMENT, EXAMINATION, APPOINTMENT AND REAPPOINTMENT OF STATE PROSECUTORS

Candidates are required to attach the scanned original of the documents listed below **OR certified / notarized** copies as.

- **Certificate of citizenship of the Republic of Kosovo;**
- **Diploma of the Faculty of Law valid in Kosovo;**
- **Valid certificate on passing the bar exam;**
- **Certificate proving that the candidate is not convicted of a criminal offense, as required by applicable law;**
- **Evidence of work experience as defined by law.**

Original documents, if required, must be submitted during the interview phase.

Additional documents

Also according to article 8 paragraph 5 of Regulation no. 07/2015 on Recruitment, Examination, Appointment and Reappointment of State Prosecutors, candidates must attach information provided by the employer for the last three (3) years of professional experience which include:

- job description,
- professional performance,
- eventual disciplinary measures and
- other issues that are considered relevant, accompanied by supporting documents, for the assessment of personal integrity and professional skills as provided in Article 20 of the Law on KPC.

If the information to be submitted is not available or fully available for the three-year period, a signed statement must be attached containing a reference to relevant professional experience and reasons for not submitting the employer information with relevant supporting documents.

The candidate must also attach, if available, professional or academic legal documents or publications, made entirely by the candidate (maximum three); Information on participation in organized forms of training in which performance is assessed (maximum three).

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR CANDIDATES

According to Article 9 paragraph 3 of Regulation no. 07/2015 on Recruitment, Examination, Appointment and Re-appointment of State Prosecutors, candidates must meet the criteria announced for the position for which they are applying, no later than the date set in the Public Competition.

The Kosovo Prosecutorial Council informs all candidates that the Recruitment Commission will verify the documents and statements submitted to support the application.

Likewise, CANDIDATES WHO HAVE NOT ATTACHED THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS WITHIN THE DEADLINE, THEIR APPLICATION WILL BE REJECTED.

Article 37 paragraph 3 of Regulation 07/2015 provides that candidates who have completed the initial examination and training organized by the Kosovo Judicial Institute will be subject only to an oral interview, the process of assessing the personal integrity and professional skills of candidates, such as also defined in Articles 23 and 24 of this Regulation.
